#### **What resources or networks have been most impactful in your career, and how would you recommend others leverage them?**

The most impactful resources in my career have been the internal networks I forged within my organization, as well as the external relationships I've built with clients, counsel, and industry peers. I've learned so much from seeking out connections with people who have different goals, perspectives, and experiences.

Trusted relationships with coworkers have been essential to helping me navigate the organization and execute tasks quickly and effectively; I've continued to nurture these relationships over time. Externally, connecting with our clients, counsel, and other industry participants has afforded me insights into broader industry trends, which ultimately assists with strategizing, planning, and pursuing new business opportunities.

I am always happy to reciprocate and share insights. I've found that people appreciate the opportunity to share their knowledge, so I'm not shy to engage and ask questions.

#### **What is the one mindset or skill you believe is essential for young professionals to build a lasting influence in structured finance?**

One important mindset for young professionals is confidence — specifically, confidence rooted in preparation and curiosity. Being someone who speaks up, asks insightful

questions, and solves problems sets them apart from others, highlights their intellectual curiosity, and showcases their potential for leadership.

**What resources or networks have been most impactful in your career, and how would you recommend others leverage them?**

**Mentors and Sponsors:** Early in my career, I sought opportunities to work with partners who were not only highly esteemed in their practice area but also generous with their time. I worked very hard to execute work product above my seniority level. My advice to young professionals is to consistently produce excellent work and ask for feedback. While it is rewarding to receive positive feedback, you learn more valuable lessons from constructive feedback. It is also important to have sponsors — people willing to advocate for you when you are not “in the room.”

**Client relationships:** Some of my most satisfying professional growth has come from long-standing client relationships. Private practice is relationship-driven. Clients have many choices when selecting legal representation. I focus on understanding each client’s unique business objectives, risk tolerance, and operational needs and constraints to develop transactional documents that will be workable for a long-term financing relationship. When you invest in client relationships in this way, you will be a significantly superior advocate for your client.

**Professional and peer networks:** In the structured finance space, SFA is a tremendous resource of thought leadership, advocacy, and professional peer networking. The task forces are a fantastic way to connect with stakeholders on targeted and emerging issues that have the potential to significantly impact our industry. Attending industry conferences is a great way to connect with peers and clients and hear expert panels discuss novel transactions, innovative structures, and other practical advice. Over time, these peers become counterparties, referral sources, and even collaborators. The structured finance space is very well interconnected.

**Technology:** We are in an environment of rapid technological developments with generative AI improving exponentially year-over-year (if not month-over-month). I believe it will have a significant impact on the practice of law as we have known it. But young lawyers should embrace it— not fear it. Learn the technology and understand where it can improve efficiency, so you can be more productive and apply your legal skills and professional judgement to develop creative solutions to complex issues.

**What is the one mindset or skill you believe is essential for young professionals to build a lasting influence in structured finance?**

Intellectual curiosity is essential in structured finance. This is a complex and multidisciplinary practice involving corporate, finance, UCC/secured transactions, bankruptcy, tax, and regulatory areas of law. Growth comes from asking “why” a deal is structured or terms are written in a particular way and how that structure or those terms mitigate risks. Representing different types of clients — issuers, borrowers, repo sellers on the one hand and underwriters, lenders, repo buyers on the other — is also very helpful. It presents issues from different perspectives that allow you to identify risks early in a transaction and resolve issues creatively. As you master a variety of transactions, you gain experience that helps you form sound judgment and deliver well-developed legal advice and strategy.
