Lisa Sotto was interviewed by several media outlets regarding the January 25 publication of the long-anticipated final Omnibus HIPAA Rule (78 Fed. Reg. 5565, 1/25/13). Sotto told several outlets that the breach notification provisions of the Rule constitute a "significant shift" from a harms-based standard to a more objective standard.
